What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English this week, we have been reading the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. We have had fun retelling the story and writing letter to the Bears. In maths, we have been learning one more and how to add two groups together.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English this week, we have been writing a non-chronological report about different homes. In Maths, we have been counting in 5s and 10s and recapping our number bonds to 10.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English we have been learning to write reports about farm animals. In maths we have been adding and subtracting, including exchanging!

<u>Year 3-</u> In English we have been learning about the features of newspaper reports. In maths, we have been problem solving using addition and subtraction.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English this week, we have been looking at the features of newspaper reports and collecting information about when the Roman's left Britain. In Maths we have been looking at methods for multiplication and division, using our times tables facts to help us calculate.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English this week, we have been writing a narrative about Leather shoe Charlie. In Maths, we have been learning how to answer multi-step word problems.

<u>Year 6-</u> In English, Children have written character descriptions about Prince Pondicherry from Chapter 3 of Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. In Maths, children have revisited multiplication and the formal written method of multiplying by two digit numbers.
