What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u>This week in English, Nursery have been reading 'Maisy makes gingerbread' and made their own gingerbread biscuits, just like Maisy. In Maths, we have been counting and matching amounts. In Reception we have been reading the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. We have been writing sentences to describe the Gingerbread Man and joined in retelling the story. In Maths, we have been learning about 'Mass and Capacity'.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, Year 1 have stepped into the role of the handbag from the story 'The Queen's Handbag' and wrote a description based on our movements through the book. In Maths, we have been learning how to build numbers within 20 using base 10.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a retell of the Tiger Child. In Maths, we have been super shop keepers, giving change.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have created their own character and have written an alternative retell for the story of Escape from Pompeii. In maths, we have been learning how to multiply a 2 digit by 1 digit number with exchange.

<u>Year 4 -</u> This week, we have been continuing to read The Vanishing Rainforest. We have written a retell and used personification to add effect. In Maths, we have been continuing to use our multiplication and division skills.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a setting description about the riverbank. In Maths, we have been learning about how to divide using the short division method.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week, Year 6 have been writing a descriptive narrative on the rainforest. Our writing was packed full of descriptive features such as: similes, adverbs and ambitious adjectives. In maths, we carried on our excellent learning on ratios and proportion.
