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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week we have been reading the story 'The Little Red Hen'. We have joined in retelling the story and made our own bread just like the character in the story.

Reception-This week in English, we have been reading 'The Little Red Hen makes a pizza'. We have made our own pizza's and sequenced the instructions. In Maths, we have been exploring numbers and comparing numbers to 5.
