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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English, we have been finding out all about Eggs and Chicks. In Maths, nursery have been counting and recognising numbers and Reception have been learning all about number bonds.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English we have been writing a recount from our Easter holidays. In Maths, we have been practically solving addition and subtraction problems

<u>Year 2-</u> In maths we have been dividing by 2,3, 5 and 10 using a grouping method. In English we have been writing descriptive sentences about our new book, The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English, we have been creating a character description of Nephoris from our story The Plot on the Pyramid. In Maths, we have been using problem solving to solve multiplication problems.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English, we have been creating a character description of the witch from our story The Lost Happy Endings. In Maths, we have been learning about multiplication and division and how we can use simple facts to help solve difficult problems.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English this week, we have started exploring a book called 'Holes'. We have been writing product descriptions, persuading the reader to buy our inventions. In Maths, we have been learning different methods of multiplying two 2-digit numbers.

<u>Year 6-</u> In English, we have been exploring Roald Dahl's take on classic fairy tales by reading his poetry collection, 'Revolting Rhymes'. In Maths we have been ordering and comparing decimals.
