What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English this week Reception have continued to learn information all about chicks and eggs. In Nursery, the children have enjoyed reading the story 'Chicken Licken'. In Maths, Reception have been learning all about 'Doubles' and Nursery have been making pictures with shapes.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English we have been writing our own animal dictionaries. In Maths, we have been solving adding and subtracting problems.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English Year 2 have been retelling stories using the past tense verbs. In Maths we have been sharing into equal groups.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English this week, Year 3 have been learning how to write and perform a play script based on our book, The Plot on the Pyramid. In maths we have been learning how to divide with exchange and remainders.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English this week, Year 4 have been writing an alternative ending to our story The Lost Happy Endings. In Maths, we have been learning how to use our prior knowledge to multiply and divide by 7 and 9.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English this week, we have been writing an informal letter based on the book 'Holes'. In Maths, we have been learning how to use the bus stop method to divide numbers.

<u>Year 6-</u> In English Year 6 have written a play script based upon their online novel, 'Seeds of Doom'. Maths this week has been spent focussing on decimals and negative numbers.

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
