What has each class been learning about this week?

- <u>EYFS-</u> In English we have been reading non fiction books all about butterflies. In Maths, we have been working hard to recognise and order numbers.
- <u>Year 1-</u> In English we have been learning our own rhyme about a penguins adventure. In Maths we have been grouping and sharing.
- <u>Year 2-</u> In English we have been writing in role for the story, 'Harry and the Jaggedy Daggers'. In Maths we have been finding a half and a quarter of numbers and shapes.
