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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week Nursery have been reading the story 'Cat's Cook Book'. We have had lots of fun exploring cook books and pretending to make recipes like the character in our story. Reception have been reading the story 'Mr Wolf's Pancakes'. We made our own pancakes and sequenced the instructions. In Maths, we have been combining 2 groups of objects and finding the total.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week Year 1 have been writing a fact file about the Queen. In Maths, we have been working on subtraction within 20.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been making little books all about India! We are now India experts! In Maths, we have been continuing to learn our 2,5 and 10x tables and use it to solve problems.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been creating their own persuasive speech to protect Pompeii from terrible tourists that are wreaking havoc on the preservation of Pompeii. In maths, we have been learning how to measure and find perimeter.

<u>Year 4 -</u> This week in English, we have been writing a poem about the destruction for the rainforest for palm oil plantations. In Maths, we have been identifying the missing lengths of shapes and finding the perimeter.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a newspaper report to the animals at the riverbank about the crime Toad from 'The wind in the willows' has committed. In Maths, we have been learning how to convert thousandths to decimals.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in English, Children have been writing a non-chronological report all about animals found in the rainforest. The children have learnt some fascinating facts and presented them superbly in their writing this week. In maths, we focused on finding
