What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week in English, we have been reading all about the Three Little Pigs and the Three Super Pigs. We have been retelling the story in Nursery and in Reception, we have been making wanted posters and describing the Big, Bad Wolf! In Maths, Nursery have been practicing their counting skills and Reception have been exploring numbers 9 and 10.
