What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English, we have been reading the story 'Supertato'. The children have had lots fun making their own 'Super Veggies'. In Maths, nursery have been making their own shape superheroes and Reception have been learning all about 3D shapes.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English, we have been planning a narrative of Amelia Earhart's. In Maths we have been looking at position and direction and learning to use the new language to describe where things are in relation to others.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English, we have been writing stories with speech based on a story set at the sea side in the past. In Maths, we have been learning about 3D shapes.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English, we have been writing a speech from the perspective of Howard Carter. In Maths, we have been earning about the addition and subtraction of fractions as well as 2D shapes.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English, we have been writing a diary entry based on the dragon attack in How to Train Your Dragon. In Maths, we have been learning about decimals and how to round them.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning about past, present and future tense - looking specifically at irregular past tense verbs. In Maths, we have been learning how to subtract mixed numbers and fractions.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in English we have started reading the novel 'Wonder' and have been writing a Diary Entry as the main character Auggie. In Maths we have calculated missing angles on a straight line, in a triangle and in a quadrilateral.
