What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English, we have been reading books all about growing plants and planted our own seeds. In Maths, we have been learning about sizes and measuring.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English we have been writing the story of Amelia Earhart. In Maths we have been recapping our place value knowledge, using the language of more than, less than, fewer than and equal to.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English this week, we have been writing postcards in role as Grandma from our class text, 'Grandma's Seaside Bloomers'. In Maths, we have started a new unit on 'Position and Direction' and are learning to use vocabulary such as 'left', 'right' and 'turn'.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English this week, we have been taking part in drama sessions and have written a character description about the BFG. We also wrote a collaborative poem with St Thomas' Leesfield. In maths we have been exploring shape, angles and lines.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English this week, we have been writing a newspaper report based on our class novel 'How To Train Your Dragon'. In Maths, we have been learning how to convert pounds to pence using decimals and using the four operations with money.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English this week, we have been writing a narrative based on the class novel, Brother Eagle, Sister Sky. In Maths, we have been learning how to multiply fractions with whole numbers.

<u>Year 6</u>- In Maths, Year 6 have been learning how to read, interpret and construct pie charts. In English they have been writing a non-chronological report based on the class novel, Wonder.
