What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week Nursery have been reading the story 'Jaspers Beanstalk'. We have followed instructions and planted our own seeds just like Jasper. Reception have been reading the story 'Supertato'. We have written our own wanted posters in literacy and in maths, we have been exploring doubles.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week we have been writing a letter about Leo's trip to fight the dragon. In Maths, we have been partitioning numbers to 100.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been describing Grandma from the story, 'Grandma's seaside bloomers!' In Maths, we have been using positional language to describe movement! The beebots have really heped us!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been creating character descriptions for Khepri, the scarab beetle from our story The Scarab's Secret. In maths, we have been learning about am and pm and have worked to read and record 24 hour times.

<u>Year 4 -</u> This week in English, Year 4 have been reading Beowulf and describing the character of Grendel. In Maths, we have started learning about time.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been reading Frankenstein. We created a role on the wall of the characters in the story. In Maths, we have been learning how to add and subtract decimal numbers.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in English, we have been reading the book 'The Legend of Rock, Paper, Scissors'. The children have loved the text and enjoyed writing a character description about the characters. In Maths, we have been planning a holiday and calculating its costs.
