## What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In English, we have been reading the story 'How to grow a dinosaur'. In maths, Nursery have been joining in counting to 10 and Reception have been learning all about sharing.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English the children have written their story of Amelia Earhart independently. In Maths we have been learning about coins and being able to recognise and add them together.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English, we have been writing a re-tell of the story, 'Pirates Love Underpants'. In Maths, we have continued our learning about 'Position and Direction' and have learnt to give directions using the vocabulary 'quarter/half/three-quarter/full turn' and 'clockwise/anti-clockwise'.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English, We have been writing our own narrative to show events that happened to Sophie at the start of the story in the BGF. In Maths, We have been investigating properties of 3D shapes.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English, we have been writing a story based upon our class text 'How To Train Your Dragon'. In Maths, we have been learning how to tell the time and convert analogue time into digital time.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning about deforestation and had a class debate about whether deforestation should be banned. In Maths, we have been learning how to convert fractions to decimals.

<u>Year 6</u>- In English, we have explored the text of 'The Legend of Rock, Paper, Scissors'. In Maths, we have converted units of time and interpreted timetables.
