What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been settling in to our new classroom, making friends and learning all about our rules and routines.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English we have been writing all about ourselves using adjectives. In maths we have been sorting objects, counting and representing numbers.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English we have been writing character descriptions of Mowgli and Baloo from The Jungle Book. In Maths we have been practising counting, reading and writing numbers to 20 and beyond.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English, we have created character descriptions of the birds in our story, Lizzie and the birds. In maths we have been learning about numbers up to 1,000.

<u>Year 4-</u> In English we have been looking at the character Medusa and describing her. We have been thinking about what type of person she is and why she is that way. In Maths we have been identifying 1000s, 100s, 10s and 1s using base 10 to support us.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English, we have been exploring our new class novel called 'Toro! Toro!'. We have been learning how to use subordinating and coordinating conjunctions in our writing. In Maths, we have been learning about place value and how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000.

<u>Year 6-</u> In English we have been using our new I-pads to research what caused World War Two. We used our research to create an informative non-chronological report. In maths we have been tackling a range of number problems. This has included ordering numbers, comparing numbers and rounding.
