What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> In Nursery, we have been learning the rhyme Baa Baa Black Sheep. In Maths, we have been exploring shapes and naming them. We had also had fun mixing colours and making our own different coloured sheep.

In Reception, we have been reading the story 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'. We have been retelling the story using words and actions. In Maths, we have learning all about the numbers 1,2 and 3.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English, we have been writing our own acrostic fruit poem and instructions on how to make a fruit kebab. In Maths, we have been working on our number bonds to 10.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English, we have been writing the story of 'The Tiger Child.' In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting on a number line.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English this week we have created our own senses poems based around our key text, The Sound Collector. In Maths we have been adding and subtracting with exchange.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week in Year 4, we have been writing a Non-Chronological Report about a Greek Mythological Creature. We then used iMovie to record these in a news report style! In Maths, we have been estimating numbers by rounding up and down.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been looking at the weather in Spain and writing a weather report. In Maths, we have been interpreting the information on a table and a timetable.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in English year 6 have been reliving their trip from last week. We have written a recount of our trip, making sure we include list sentences, relative clauses and passive voice. In maths we have been making sure we can remember the four operations, which year 6 have done expertly.
