



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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u>This week Nursery have been learning all about Bonfire Night. We had lots of fun building a bonfire, drinking hot chocolate and learning how Bonfire Night is celebrated. In maths we have been making fireworks using 2D shapes.

<u>Reception -</u> This week we have been reading the story 'Room on the Broom'. We have been writing our own potions and had lots of fun retelling the story. In Maths, we have been learning numbers 1,2,3 and began to explore '1 more'.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English, we have been creating our own Fire shape poem. In Maths, we have been finding the difference and learning to count on to solve addition problems.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been reading the text, 'The Man on the Moon.' They have loved acting in role as Bob! In maths, we have been adding and subtraction using the column method. We have loved learning about character competencies and have been playing lots of turn taking games to improve our communication skills!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week Year 3 have been having fun following instructions based on our book 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth'. In maths, we have been problem solvers, working with addition and subtraction and breaking codes!

<u>Year 4-</u> This week year 4 have been looking at Measurements in Maths and conversions. In English, we have been looking at Castleshaw and have created a travel leaflet! On Thursday we went to Castleshaw. This week for our Pledge Launch we have been completing activities for 'Problem Solving', 'Co-operative' and 'Resilient'. We worked alongside Year 3 to make a treasure map and riddles, and solve them. We have had lots of fun this week!

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning all about mosques. We have been writing setting descriptions and describing mosques. In Maths, we have been learning how to use counters to help us identify multiples and factors.
