What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week we have been reading a story called 'Mum and Dad make me laugh'. We used the story to help us to learn about patterns. We have also explored Diwali and made some fantastic Diva lamps.

<u>Reception-</u> This week, we have been learning all about Diwali and how it is celebrated. In Maths, we have been learning about 2D shapes and their properties.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English, we have been writing instructions on 'What to do if there is a fire'. In Maths, we have been doing subtraction by crossing out and jumping back along a number line.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been writing a diary as Bob, 'The Man on the Moon.' They have used super sentence openers and feeling words! In Maths, we have been recognising coins and counting money. In History, we have been looking at 'The Race to Space!' and learning about the first man on the moon!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week, Year 3 have been writing instructions for how to wash a woolly mammoth. In maths, we have been subtracting 3 digit numbers and have moved onto subtracting 3 digit numbers with exchange.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week, Year 4 have been continuing to write their recount for our Castleshaw trip. In Maths, we have been finding the perimeter of shapes. We started our Geography Topic this week and used our Map skills to find the four countries within the United Kingdom and identify the capital cities and surrounding seas/oceans. This moved us nicely on to looking at Europe.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing persuasive leaflets about Islamic countries! In Maths, we have been using counters in arrays to find factors of numbers and to make square and cube numbers.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week Year 6 have been recreating a page from the book 'My Secret War Diary'. This has involved writing 3 genres within our extended write: a diary, a descriptive narrative and a non-chronological report. Ask us about what we have learnt about The Blitz. In maths we have been continuing our work with fractions, where we have mastered how to add fractions with different denominators.
