### What has each class been learning about this week?

Nursery - This week, we have been reading the story 'Here are my hands'. In Maths, we have been using our hands to count and we have been working hard to count all the way to 10!

<u>Reception-</u> This week in English, we have been reading the story 'Kippers Birthday' and writing our own invitations. In Maths, we have been learning 'One More'.

<u>Vear 1-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a fact file about dinosaurs and building sentences to describe them. In Maths, we have been recognising and naming 2D and 3D shapes.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week in English, we have been creating our own ending to the story 'The way back home' In Maths, we have been learning how to find the total and give change! In Science, this week, we created a map of the playground and went on a search for minibeasts in their microhabitats- it was really exciting!

<u>Vear 3-</u> This week in English we have been creating a diary entry from the perspective of The Stone Age boy. In Maths, we have been creating equal groups and sharing to show division. In art, we have been creating cave paintings with different mediums.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week in Year 4 we have been multiplying and dividing, In English we have been writing a narrative of 'Gregory the Greenfield Giant'. In Science, we have identified how sounds are made, associating some sounds with something vibrating. We added rice to drums to see the vibrations.

<u>Year 5-</u> In English this week, we have been writing a narrative retell about The Golden Horsemen of Baghdad. In Maths, we have been learning about how to calculate the perimeter of rectangles.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week Year 6 have been writing a descriptive narrative about when Bruno met Schmaul in 'A Boy in Striped Pyjamas'. We used a large range of descriptive features to bring our writing to life and Mr Davison was super impressed with how hard we all worked. In maths we have focused on tricky time problems. In topic we spent a whole afternoon creating model Anderson Shelters - which was really fun and interesting.

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
