What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week we have joining in the song 'This is me' and thinking about our bodies. In mathematics we have been recapping shapes and making shape pictures.

<u>Reception-</u>This week in literacy, we have been reading the story 'Stickman' and writing missing posters to help to find him. In maths, we have been learning all about one less and counting down.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week, Year 1 have been writing up their story of Dipsy the Dinosaur firefighter. In Maths, we have been learning to partition numbers and count one more and one less within 20.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been learning about the 'The First Moon Landing.' They have produced marvellous missing posters of Laika- the space dog. In Maths, we have been learning about multiplication and have been making arrays.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week, Year 3 have been learning about 'The Secrets of Stonehenge. We created our very own mini version of Stonehenge by following instructions. In maths, we have been learning how to divide and multiply by 3. We had lots of fun in art creating our own class cave painting (See the blog for pictures!)

<u>Year 4-</u> This week, Year 4 have been continuing to read Charlottes Web. We researched facts about spiders and up-levelled our sentences using superlatives. In Maths we have been continuing to work on our Times tables.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning all about the many different inventions during the Golden age. We have been looking at the features of instructions. In Maths, we have been learning how to calculate the area of squares and rectangles.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week Year 6 have begun learning about newspaper articles. We have focused on using reported and direct speech in our writing and we have done really well so far. In maths we have been learning how to plot, reflect and find co-ordinates. Freddy Fit also visited, where we got to do lots of fun exercise.
