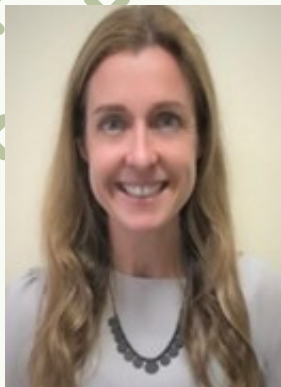


Westwood Academy Newsletter

Year Group Meetings

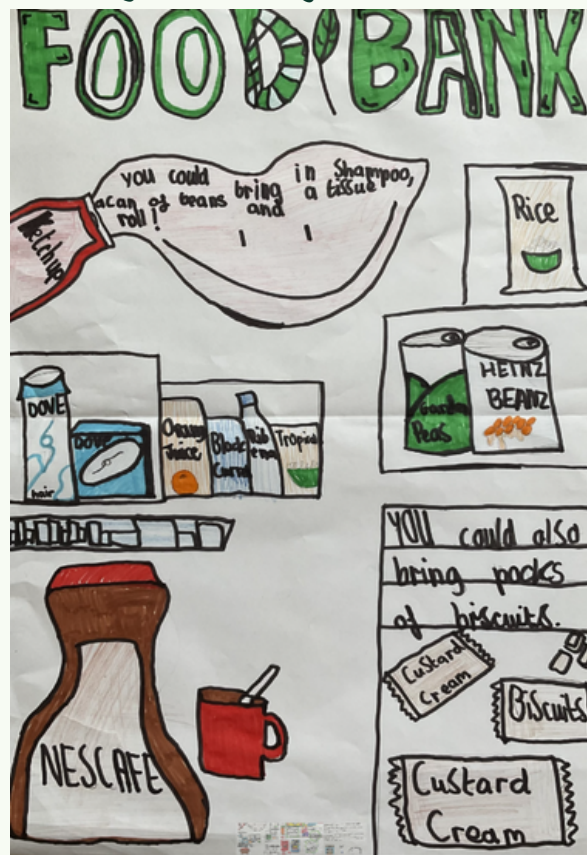
