What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week we have been reading the story 'Dear Santa'. In maths we have been doing lots of counting and working hard to recognise our numbers.

<u>Reception-</u> This week we have been reading the story 'Dear Santa'. In maths, we have started to explore and name 3D shapes.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week Year 1 have been writing instructions on how to make bread. In Maths, we have been working on ordering amounts and numbers within 20.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have become space experts writing non-chronological reports all about 'The First Moon Landing!' They are full of facts, technical space vocabulary and subheadings. In maths, we have been drawing our own arrays to solve multiplication problems! In DT, we have been deciding on the best materials to make our very own moon buggy.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week we have been working really hard writing an explanation text all about Stonehenge! We made sure we researched lots of facts, used 2a sentences and fronted adverbials to make sure it was a brilliant explanation text. In maths we have been revising multiplication and division, where we have shown we are expert learners.

<u>Year 4-</u> We have been writing non-chronological reports on spiders. We learnt all about how many eyes they have and Miss Barlow was shocked by how hairy spiders are. In maths we have been revising the four operations and showing how much we have remembered.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing instructions on how to perform wudhu correctly. In Maths, we have been learning how to multiply numbers using the multiplication grid.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week we have been continuing our work with newspaper reports. We have ensured that our newspaper contained formal language, direct/indirect speech and lots of facts.
