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What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- In EYFS we have had a very busy week performing our Christmas Nativity for the whole school and for our parents. We have had lots of fun joining in lots of Christmas activities and learning all about the story of Christmas.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a non-chronological report about The Great Fire of London and writing as letter to Santa. In Maths, we have been recapping our fact families, number bonds and using a number line.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week in English, we have written a letter to the man on the moon and released it into the sky using balloons. In Maths, we have been learning about money and buying Christmas presents.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, we have been describing our character, The Christmassaurus and we have written short elf poems. In maths, we have been multiplying and dividing by 8.
