# What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week in Nursery and Reception we have been reading the story 'The Tiger Who Came For Tea'. We have written our own shopping lists, had a tea party and even made patterns that look like the Tigers fur. We have had lots of fun!

<u>Year 1-</u> This week Year 1 have been writing and invitation to a tea party! We had our tea party on Friday! In Maths we have been recapping our one more and one less within 10 and 20.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been learning to multiply by 2, 5 and 10! In English, we have been reading the story, 'The Egg Drop.' We have made egg protectors and dropped them from a high window! Only one survived! Then, we wrote some excellent explanations using conjunctions.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week we have been creating a new character for our story 'The Wild Girl' in English. In maths, we have been learning how to multiply 2 digit by 1 digit numbers. In Topic, we have been learning about the changes in settlements from The Stone Age to The Bronze Age.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week year 4 have been reading 'Romulus and Remus' in English. We have created freeze frames and story maps. On Friday, we wrote a letter to King Numitor, in first person (Romulus), telling him of life in his new city of Rome! In Maths we have been working on our Multiplication and Division skill, finding factor pairs.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week we have been learning about Shackleton and his journey to the South Pole. In English, we have been writing letters to apply for a job to be part of Shackleton's crew. In Maths, we have been learning how to use the bus stop method when dividing.

<u>Year 6</u> - This week we have been working hard in maths, learning how to use protractors accurately and how to calculate angles as well. In English we have started our new topic on South America. We have been reading the book 'The Great Kapok Tree' and will be writing about why we should save the rainforest.
