

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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been learning all about the celebration Chinese New Year. We have been reading non-fiction books to find out new information to help us with our learning. In maths, Nursery have been using shapes to create dragons. Reception have continued to look at numbers and focussed on numbers 6 and 7.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in Maths, we have been writing fact families and comparing numbers within 20. In English, we have been writing about the handbags feeling, and learning to write speech.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been reading the story, 'The Monster Machine!' We have described the hairy, scary monsters and have written instructions about how to make our own marvellous monsters! In maths, we have been creating our own block graphs using Purple Mash!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in year 3, we have been exploring key events from the stone ages and researching facts in English. In Maths, we have been giving change and have begun to explore handling data in the form of tally marks.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week, Year 4 have been solving Fractions in Maths. In English, we have research Julius Caesar

and we wrote a biography. In Science, we put the parts of the digestive system together and labelled them.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been reading a new book called The Polar Bears Explorers club. We have been looking at chapters of the book and creating soundscapes using musical instruments. In Maths, we have been learning how to multiply fractions with whole numbers.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week Year 6 have had an absolutely fantastic week as we have been on our residential trip to Robinwood. The boys and girls got to try a whole range of fantastic new experiences and many of us conquered some of our fears. Our favourite activities included the zip line, climbing wall and piranha pool.

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
