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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been reading the story Goldilocks and the Three Bears. Nursery have been retelling the story using words and actions and Reception have been writing letters to Baby Bear. In Maths Nursery have been exploring sizes and Reception have been looking at numbers 9 and 10 and putting numbers in order.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a diary entry from the little pig, based on the story of The Three Little Pigs. In Maths, we have been counting in 2s and 5s.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, in Year 2, have been writing a set of instructions for the lazy, idle farmer. In Maths, we have been learning about the properties of 3D shapes.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been learning all about the eruption at Pompeii in 79AD. We created character descriptions based on our story Escape from Pompeii. In maths, we have been learning about measure and length.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week in English, year 4 have been learning about Roman Soldier recruitment. We have designed our own recruitment posters! In maths, we have continued to work on solving fractions of amounts. We are becoming expert learners and impressing Miss O'Brien every day!

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning about characterisation and how to used actions and dialogue to describe a character. In Maths, we have been learning about percentages. We have been learning how to convert decimals to fractions and percentages.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in maths we have learnt all about ration and proportion. We learn about how we can scale up or down ingredient amounts depending on how many people we were baking for, which will come in handy when we're older, or even now!



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
