

What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week we have been reading the story 'The Three Little Pigs'. We have enjoyed joining in with the repeated phrases and pretending to be the characters. In Maths, we have been learning about more and less, greater and fewer.

Year 1- This week we have been learning how to measure objects with non-standard units. In English, we wrote a persuasive letter to the wolf to ask him not to blow our houses down.

Year 2- This week, Year 2 have been writing incredible instructions using time adverbials, imperative verbs and adverbs for the idle farmer. In Maths, we have been finding fractions of shapes. In Science, we have learnt about the life cycle of a frog and created our own frog books!

Year 3- This week in English, Year 3 have been creating an escape story in English inspired by our story Escape from Pompeii. The children created their own characters and ways of escaping the eruption. In maths, we have further explored length and perimeter and have been adding, subtracting and comparing different length amounts.

Year 4- This week in Maths, year 4 have been continuing to work on solving fraction problems. In English, we have been writing a diary as a Roman Soldier. We started our new Science Topic too on Heating and Cooling, we really enjoyed starting our new Topic.

Year 5- This week, in English we have been writing a narrative retell about a young boy called Charlie, who moved to Manchester to work in a factory during the Victorian era. In Maths, we have been learning how to add and subtract decimal numbers.

Year 6- This week year 6 have been writing a newspaper report, focusing on using direct speech, indirect speech and snappy headlines. In maths, we have been ensuring that we know all the different shape names and learning the properties of these different shapes.
