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#### What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been learning all about the Easter story through the book 'We're going on an egg hunt'. The children have had lots of fun making their own books, going on an egg hunt and learning about the Easter celebration. In our number work we have been making and copying repeated patterns using lots of different colours and objects.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week, we have been writing our instructions: How to build a house. In Maths, we have been recapping our addition and subtraction.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week in Year 2, we have been learning to solve problems using length. In English, we have written an amazing recount about the break in from the hairy horse!

In Art, we have completed our amazing farm collages!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English\_we have been creating an explanation text to explain\_how earth quakes occur and what to do if you are unfortunate to be caught up in one. In maths, we have been counting in fractions and finding equivalents of 2/4 and halves.
