What has each class been learning about this week?

- <u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been learning all about how Eid is celebrated. We have been sharing our news from home about Eid and drawing and writing about what we did. In Maths, Nursery have been exploring 3D shapes and using them to build mosques. Reception, have been continuing with number bonds to 5 & 10.
- <u>Year 1-</u> This week we have been writing a missing poster for our pet penguin Polly. In Maths, we have been learning how to make equal groups and arrays to help us count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- <u>Year 2-</u> This week, in Year 2 we have been learning to tell the time. In English, we have been doing lots of grammar practise and sorting words into nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. In Science, we have created a poster about the importance of washing our hands.
- <u>Year 3-</u> This week in English we have created and preformed playscripts as our favourite character from our story The Plot on the Pyramid. In maths, we have been learning how to find fractions of an amount.

- <u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing letters as Stanley to his mum about his horrible time at Camp Green Lake. In Maths, we have been learning about co-ordinates and plotting co-ordinates on a grid.
