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What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week Nursery have been joining in the rhyme 'Old MacDonald'. The children have been exploring animals that live on the farm and have enjoyed making their own animal masks. Reception have continued their learning all about 'Chicks' and have been writing about the life cycle of a chicken. In Maths, we have been looking at number patterns beyond 10.

<u>Year 1-</u> In English, we have been writing our recount of our trip to the zoo. In Maths, we have been learning how to find a quarter of a shape, a quarter of an amount and solve problems finding a quarter.

<u>Year 2-</u> In English, we have been writing Non-Chronological Reports about different types of holidays. We have used subheadings, conjunctions and different sentence types. In Maths, we have been calculating durations of time! We had lots of fun in science this week, looking at different types of teeth using mirrors.

<u>Year 3-</u> In English, Year 3 have been writing excellent Egyptian shape poems using rhyme, alliteration and onomatopoeia. In Maths we have been tackling tricky time, working out minutes to, minutes past as well as 24 and 12 hour clocks!

<u>Year 4-</u> In English, Year 4 have been writing narrative poetry for Beowulf. We then performed our poems in small groups. In Maths, we have been learning to read the time to 5 minutes. To end the half term, in History we had Wattle and Daub houses using clay, straw and water!

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing non-chronological reports about yellow spotted lizards from the book 'Holes'. In Maths, we have been learning how to convert different measurements.

<u>Year 6-</u> In English, Year 6 have really enjoyed writing a short story based on a video about a mysterious missing girl. In topic we attended our first meeting for Business Enterprise and have decided on a product to sell. We look forward to sharing our product with you in the coming weeks.



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
