What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been learning all about the Queen and the Jubilee. Nursery have been drawing fantastic portraits of the Queen and Reception have been writing facts about her. In Maths, Nursery have been learning how to match numeral to quantity and Reception have been learning how to add using 'First, Then, Now'

<u>Year 1-</u> This week, in English, we have been reading the text, 'Amelia Earhart.' We have enjoyed finding out that Amelia was the first woman to fly on her own across the Atlantic Ocean! In Maths, we have been learning about turns and positions. We are practising using words such as left, right, forwards and backwards.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been written super seaside poems using vivid verbs! In Maths, we have been learning about position and direction. In History, we explored paintings and photographs to discover what the seaside was like in the past. We are VERY excited to visit the seaside next week!

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been creating Roald Dahl fact files. In maths, we have been finding and comparing duration.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week in English, Year 4 have been looking at the features of newspaper reports for a Dragon sighting. In Maths we have been continuing to tell the time on 12-hour clocks and 24-hour clocks. <u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been learning about past, present and future tense. We have been focusing on irregular past tense verbs. In Maths, we have been learning how to interpret information on a timetable.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week Year 6 have been really enjoying the book 'The legend of Rock, Paper and Scissors'. We have written a character description on these characters using lots of descriptive features. In maths we have enjoyed using our maths skills to plan a holiday.

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
