What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week we have been finding out about the lifecycle of a frog. Nursery made some fantastic frogs using collage and reception did some brilliant writing to share what they know about frogs. In Maths, Nursery have been learning all about positional language and Reception have been learning how to 'Take away'.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English we have been writing a description about being on a plane! In Maths we have been practicing counting one more and one less and also partitioning our numbers into tens and ones.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, in English, we have created amazing adverts to persuade people to visit Lytham St Anne's beach! In Maths, we used beebots to help us to learn about half turns, quarter turns, clockwise and anti-clockwise! <u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, we have moulded ourselves into he BFG and have created a superb setting description of the BFG's cave. In maths, we have been learning about shapes and angles and worked our to complete our reasoning and arithmetic quizzes.
