


What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week Nursery have been reading the story 'The Rainbow Fish' and thinking about how we can be nice friends to one another. In maths, the children explored shapes and how to make pictures by joining shapes together. Reception have been reading the story 'Billy's Bucket' and using their imaginations to say what they could see in their buckets. In Maths, we started our learning all about 'Odds and Evens' and sharing.

Year 1- This week in English, we have been writing an explanation about cars! We have been learning all about money in Maths.

Year 2- This week in English, we have written recounts all about our terrific trip to the seaside. In maths, we have been measuring mass using grams! We enjoyed science this week, planting our own cress seeds and investigating what they need to survive.

Year 3- This week in English, Year 3 have been writing some fantastic narrative pieces based on the introduction to the BFG. In maths, we have been making and exploring 2D and 3D shapes. We have also looked at the physical and human features of Egypt in Geography.

Year 4- This week in English, Year 4 have been writing a non-chronological report. In Maths, we have started our new topic of position and direction. We looked at clockwise and anticlockwise along with $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ turns. In Science, we investigated which materials were the best conductors.

Year 5- This week in English, we have been writing a letter to the council to inform and persuade them to stop deforestation. In Maths, we have been recapping our learning on addition and subtraction while answering multi-step word problems.

Year 6- This week year 6 were lucky enough to go on a trip to Oldham Sixth Form College, where we got to do amazing experiments involving burning metals, dissolving skittles and creating lava lamps! We also enjoyed selling our products (bookmarks) to all the children in school.

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
