What has each class been learning about this week?

EYFS- This week, we have been reading lots of books about Pirates. We have designed our own treasure maps and have been describing the characters in our stories. In Maths, Nursery have been counting treasure for the pirates and Reception have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Year 1- This week we have been writing a non-chronological report about transport from past and present. In Maths, we have been learning to write and tell the time to half past and compare different time.

Year 2- This week in English, Year 2 completed an alternative retell of The Lighthouse Keeper's Cat. The children's writing was packed full of features and so fun to read! In Maths, Year 2 have been learning all about temperature.
