What has each class been learning about this week?

- <u>EYFS-</u> This week, we have been exploring our new classroom and we have been learning all about our rules and routines.
- <u>Year 1-</u> This week in Maths we have been looking at and counting to our numbers to 10. In English, we have drawn, labelled and wrote a sentence all about our face.
- <u>Year 2-</u> This week in English, we wrote a delightful description about Pippin, the country mouse. In Maths, we have been reading numbers up to 100 and working out how many tens and ones are in each number.
- <u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, we have been describing characters from our story, Lizzie and the birds. In Maths we have been learning how to represent and partition numbers to 100.
- <u>Year 4-</u> This week in English, we have been describing Medusa, the Gorgon in the Greek Myths. In Maths, we have even identifying numbers up to 1000 and estimating on a number line. We started our Topic on Ancient Greece, ordering events on a timeline.
- <u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been creating a story board and writing our own story about what we would do if we were stuck on a hot air balloon. In Maths, we have been learning about place value and focusing on numbers up to 100,000.
- <u>Year 6-</u> This week year 6 have really enjoyed getting stuck into_our new topic WW2. We have learned about the key events and are building up to an explanation text on what triggered WW2. In maths we have been testing our place value skills.

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
