What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>EYFS-</u> This week in English, we started to practice writing our names. In Maths, we had lots of fun singing number songs. Reception also had their first music lesson with Mrs Brocklehurst and they all had a fantastic time.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, we have been describing ourselves and what we look like using adjectives. In Maths, we have been finding one more and one less than amounts within 10.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have been writing the story of 'The Town Mouse and The Country Mouse.' We have been using lots of descriptive words! In Maths, we have been partitioning two digit numbers and saying how many tens and how many ones they have.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been writing a retell of our story, Lizzie and the birds. We used time conjunctions and subordinating conjunctions to expand our sentences. In maths, we have been learning how to make and partition numbers to 1000.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week Year 4 have been writing a setting description for Medusa's cave. We used words such as 'mouth', 'unknown' and 'dark hole' to up-level our vocabulary. In Maths, we have been continuing to work on partitioning numbers up to 10,000.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a setting description about Verona. In Maths, we have been looking at numbers to a million and partitioning them.

<u>Year 6-</u> This week in English, we have been explaining why WW2 started. The children have shown they are experts already and have written fantastic explanation texts. In maths, we have been learning about rounding, addition and subtraction.

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
