What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week Nursery have been focussing their learning on the nursery rhyme 'Twinkle, Twinkle'. We have sang the rhyme, played instruments and made our own Twinkle Star.

<u>Reception -</u> This week in English, we have been reading the story 'Families, Families, Families' and drawing our own families. In Maths, we have been learning all about subitising and how to quickly recognise a number without counting.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week we have been inspired by the Colour Monster and have written about our own feelings. In Maths, we have introduced Part- Whole models and learnt to write number sentences.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have written incredible instructions about 'How to make Hedgehog bread!' In Maths, we have been comparing and ordering numbers up to 100. We really enjoyed our Geography lesson this week, learning about different types of farms.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, Year 3 have been creating a 1st person story, inspired by our class story, The Secret of Black Rock. In maths, we have been using our knowledge of 100s, 10s and 1s to order and compare numbers up to 1000.

<u>Year 4-</u> This week in English, Year 4 have been writing a retell for Perseus and the Snake-Haired Monster! In Maths, we have been rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000.

<u>Year 5-</u> This week in English, we have been writing letters to Romeo as Juliet, about whether or not we want to marry him. In Maths, we have been learning how to round numbers up to a million.

<u>Year 6 -</u> This week in English, we have been writing a descriptive story all about a soldier trying to escape Dunkirk. In maths, we have tackled long multiplication where lots of pupils have shown excellent effort in class.





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
