What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week, Nursery have been learning the rhyme 'Baa Baa Black Sheep'. In Maths, we have been exploring 2D shapes and learning the different names. We have also been finding out what happens when colours are mixed to make our own colourful sheep.
