What has each class been learning about this week?

<u>Nursery-</u> This week Nursery have been reading the story 'My Five Senses' and learning about the different features. In maths, we have been learning how to subitise and quickly recognise numbers.

<u>Reception-</u> This week in English, we have been reading the story 'The Scarecrows Wedding'. We have made our own scarecrows and wrote shopping lists for the scarecrows wedding. In Maths, we have been learning 'One Less' and have been trying to quickly recall the numbers that are one less.

<u>Year 1-</u> This week in English, we have been writing a diary entry as Samuel Pepys, we wrote the early events of the Great Fire of London. In Maths, we have been looking at and building 3D shapes.

<u>Year 2-</u> This week, Year 2 have written delightful diary entries in the role of 'Bob' the astronaut. In Maths, we have been sorting shapes by their properties.

<u>Year 3-</u> This week in English, we have begun to explore how Stonehenge was created. We have, so far, researched facts and created an instruction blog to create our own model of Stonehenge.
